

All laws of State legislatures that in any manner interfere with the free sale of Patent rights, such as the requiring of the agent or patentee to file copies or patent, take licenses, procure certificates, comply with forms or which release the payee of ordinary notes of hand given for patents, have been declared unconstitutional and void by the United States Courts. All State judges, sheriffs, or other State officials, who undertake to interfere with patentees or their agents in the free sale of patents, make themselves liable in damages and other punishment.
