



FOREIGN PATENTS.

Their Cost Reduced.

The expenses attending the procuring of patents in most foreign countries having been considerably reduced, the obstacle of cost is no longer in the way of a large proportion of our inventors patenting their inventions abroad.

A good invention is likely to realize as much for the patentee in England as his United States patent produces for him at home, and the small cost now renders it possible for almost every patentee in this country to secure a patent in Great Britain, where his rights are as well protected as in the United States.

OTHER COUNTRIES, -Patentsare also obtained on very reasonable terms in France, Belgium, Germany Austria, Russia, Italy, Spain (the latter includes Cuba and all the other Spanish Colonies), Brazil, British India, Australia, and the other British Colonies.
