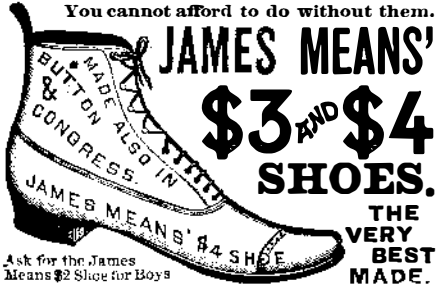

TRAMWAY, FLEXIBLE GIRDER.—Description of an improved system of constructing a modification of the well known and extensively used rope or wire tramway.

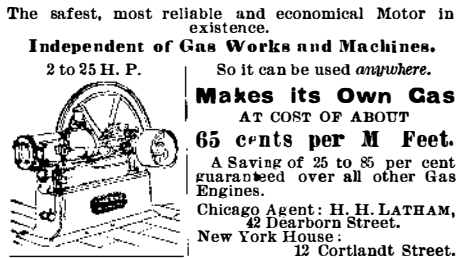

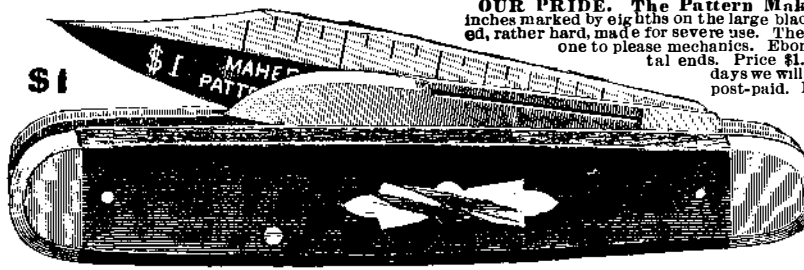
