

The claim is not for these several things in and of themselves, but for an electric telephone in the construction of which these things or any of them are used."

This Company also owns Letters Patent No. 463,569, granted to Emile Berliner, November 17, 1891, for a Combined Telegraph and Telephone; and controls Letters Patent No. 474,231, granted to Thomas A.
