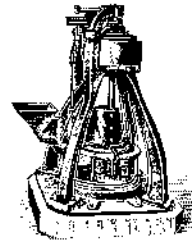

MINISTRY OF PUBLIC WORKS. CAIRO, EGYPT. The Egyptian Government puts up to adjudication the construction and working of a tramway line of narrow gauge from Mansourah to Menzaleh and Matarieh, with its branch lines, on the conditions of the act of concession and the specification, copies of which will be forwarded to those who apply for them by letter addressed to the Minister of Public Works, Cairo, Egypt. Offers will be received at this Ministry up to noon on the 1st February, 1894. Persons tendering should indicate the width of the line, and all other dispositions relative to the type of permanent way and rolling stock, and the term for which they require the concession. This term may not exceed forty years.
