GREAT REDUCTION IN

RUSSIAN PATENTS

NEW LAW NOW IN FORCE.

On the 13th of July, a new Russian patent law went into effect, reducing the cost of obtaining the patent and increasing the term to 15 years. We can now procure a Russian patent for \$125 in ordinary cases. The price formerly was from \$200 to \$450 for a patent of from 3 to 10 years. Annual taxes will be payable. The application should be filed before the issue of the United States patent.

Patents granted under the old law may, if still in force, be extended to the full term of 15 years, counting from the original date, by paying all the annuities that would have become due if the new law had been in operation at the time the application was filed.

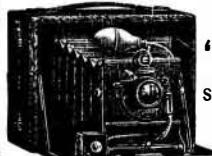

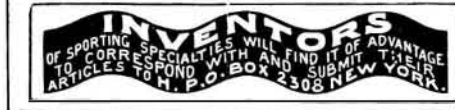
