Beautiful Blue Ridge Mountains.

If you are going to New York, a treat is in store for you if you take the Lackawanna Railroad. This line offers the most beautiful scenery of any of the great trunk lines of the East, traversing the beautiful agricultural regions of western New York until it reaches the Susquehanna River, beside which it runs for miles, overlooking the beautiful valleys nestled in among the foot-hills of the Blue Ridge Mountains. Next it reaches the valley of the Delaware River, which the trains follow through Delaware Water Gap, conceded to be one of the most picturesque spots in America, the river and the railroad track fighting for the right of way through a great gap in the mountains, cut by the ceaseless washing of the waters of the river. For miles the track curves in and about the Blue Ridge Mountains, each successive turn presenting a picture seemingly more beautiful than the last. At Mount Pocono an altitude of 1940 feet is reached, and from here on the train descends through the mountains and foot-hills almost to the edge of the Hudson River, the last hundred miles having been for the most part beside the picturesque old Morris and Essex Canal.
