



Should the wire be bare or covered? A. A rheostat can be made for a handfeed arc lamp to consume 10 amperes with about 500 feet of No. 12 German silver wire. Bare wire is to be used, as the heat would burn the insulation and make a bad odor. Twice the quantity of iron wire of the same size may be used. The rheostat should be made so as to be varied and adjusted to the condition of carbons and current.


