Mr. Jervis has succeeded in producing a most handsome volume on a subject which has, perhaps, been hitherto best treated in European books. The value of his work as a reference book can be determined only by fairly long use. The examination which we have given the work convinces us that it is one which should find a place in the library of every ceramic artist. Its scope is wide, its treatment sufficiently minute for an encyclopedia, and its trustworthiness above reproach.
