**EXPERIMENTAL SCIENCE** is so well known to many of our readers that it is hardly necessary now to give a description of this work. The construction of the machine is perfect enough to admit of enlarging or reducing its size if desired.

Volume II contains much on the general subject of electricity, besides new articles of great importance. Among these the subject of alternate current machinery is treated. Wireless Telegraphy and Telephone receive attention. Electrical Measuring Instruments, The Electric Clock, The Telegraphone, Experiments in High Voltage, The Nernst Lamp, and Measuring the Heat of the Stars are all thoroughly illustrated and described.
