**Experimental Science** BY George M. Hopkins

The construction of the machine is perfect enough to admit of enlarging or reducing its size if desired.  
Volume II contains much on the general subject of electricity, besides new articles of great importance. Among these the subject of alternate current machinery is treated. Wireless Telegraphy and Telephony receive attention. Electric Measuring Instruments, The Electric of the Stars are all thoroughly illustrated and described.
