

most recent type of coal- and gas-fired re-heating furnaces, mechanical chargers, and various appliances for handling the materials at the reheating furnaces and transferring them to the mills. Section IV. describes the properties of finished steel. The influence of impurities on the mechanical properties of steel is thoroughly discussed, as is also the important subject of its heat treatment and the pyrometers used in connection with the same. The relation of microstructure to heat treatment is fully illustrated by numerous micro-photographs, and the latest theories on hardening, tempering, and other matters of much interest and importance are discussed. The question of specifications, both as regards chemical composition and mechanical properties of various steels, is treated in an appendix. Other appendices contain valuable matter on the relation of percentage of carbon to tensile stress, and on the rapid determination of phosphorus and manganese.
