GOVERNMENT OF BERMUDA.	
Tenders for Deepening, Widening and Buoying St. George's Channel.	
The Crown Agents for the Colonies, London, England, are prepared, on behalf of the Government of Bermuda, to receive tenders for the deepening, widening and buoying of the Channel leading from Saint George's Harbour in the Islands of Bermuda.	
The Channel has been surveyed by persons appointed by the Government of Bermuda, and on and after the 27th of January, 1905, a plan, drawing, sections, form of contract and form of tender may be seen daily by intending contractors at the office of the British Consul-General, 17 State Street, between the hours of 11 A. M. and 3 P. M.	
On application to the Consul-General and on payment of 20 pounds, persons or firms wishing to submit tenders will receive two copies of the form of contract and form of tender and will be allowed to make copies of the plan, drawings and sections showing the work to be executed under the contract. The above sum will be returned to each person or firm submitting a bona fide tender properly completed in all respects within the time specified below.
