ITS MANUFACTURE ITS DENATURIZATION ITS INDUSTRIAL USE

The Cost of Manufacturing Denaturated Alcohol in Germany and German Methods of Denaturization are discussed by Consul-General Frank H. Mason in SCIENTIFIC AMERICAN SUPPLEMENT 1550.

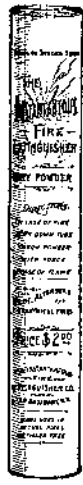
