DESIGNS FOR BATTLESHIPS.—The Navy Department invites the attention of competent naval constructors in the United States to the opportunity afforded by the Act of Congress (Public No. 330) to submit plans and specifications for a battleship. Preliminary plans will be received under seal on November 1, 1906, which preliminary plans, with the attendant specifications, shall show the displacement, draft and dimensions of the battleship proposed and the speed and estimated cost, and likewise within what time completed plans and specifications for the construction of such vessel will be furnished, if desired by the Department, and finally, what amount will be deemed by the said constructor just and equitable compensation for the said preliminary and the said completed plans, should the same or either of the same be paid for by the Department in accordance with the terms of the statute aforesaid. A copy of the Departmental circular on the subject will be sent on request addressed to the Navy Department, Washington, D. C.
